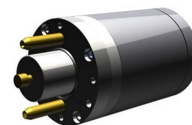

## Product Spotlight: Rota-Flex Rotary Indexer

The Welker Rota-Flex is a positive lock mechanical indexer for trunnion fixtures, model change-over tooling, and small dial tables.
